A BABY TOOTH IS KNOCKED OUT

CONTACT US AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. QUICK ACTION CAN PREVENT INFECTION RINSE THE MOUTH WITH WATER AND APPLY COLD COMPRESSES TO REDUCE SWELLING

CHIPPED OR BROKEN

EVENT INFECTION AND REDUCE ENEED FOR EXTENSIVE DENTAL EATMENT. RINSE THE MOUTH WITH ITER AND APPLY COLD

IF A PARENT CAN FIND THE BROKEN TOOTH FRAGMEN TAKE IT



A PERMANENT TOOTH IS KNOCKED OUT

FIND THE TOOTH. RINSE IT GENTLY IN COOL WATER. DO NOT SCRUB IT OR USE SOAP.

REPLACE THE TOOTH IN THE SOCKET AND HOLD IT THERE WITH CLEAN WASH-CLOTH. IF YOU CAN'T PUT THE TOOTH BACK IN THE SOCKET, PUT THE TOOTH IN A CLEAN CONTAINER, WITH COLD MILK. IF MILK ISN'T AVAILABLE, USE THE CHILD'S SALIVA, BUT NOT IN WATER.
